

# KART KAMP 2010

## Purpose

The Northern California Bernese Mountain Dog Club sponsors the Kart Kamp to promote carting skills and offer intense preparation for future Draft Tests,

The original idea of Kart Kamp, was an informal working gathering of folks interested in carting and who would like to work on sharpening their skills and relationship with their Dogs and carting. This has transformed into a weekend of formal instruction and discussion; video presentations, lots of time to work with our dogs and a practice Draft Test, judged by accredited BMDCA Draft Judges. Pat & Fred Helmbold host Kart Kamp at their home in Sugar Pine, where there is ample room for obedience work, maneuvering practice, and trails for freight hauls. Several surprise variations to carting and informal contests will offer new insight into the carting experience. The location offers a wide variety of surfaces and terrain to train our dogs, while enjoying the mountains, some wine, good food and exchanging carting experiences. The Kamp has limited registrations to provide the best instruction to each working team.

Kart Kamp participants and their dogs should have a basic working relationship with their carts, and a familiarity with the rules for a Draft Test. 7. Group Stays and Short Freight Haul

1. Walk through Expanded Draft Rally Course

  - b. Draft Rally hunt – picking up objects
3. Practice Down Stays and actual Freight Haul -
4. Water / rest dogs – discuss conditioning
5. Carting Fun & Games with your dogs - 2 winners pick draft position for Practice Draft Test Match on Sunday

## DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO SUGAR PINE

### Coming from San Jose/Bay Area

1. Get out of the Bay Area, take I-560 through Livermore, I-205 to Tracy and I-5 to Manteca, take 120 around Manteca, North on State Highway 99 [toward Sacramento].
2. Take the **FIRST TURN OFF AFTER GETTING ON 99, WHICH IS AGAIN, HIWAY 120 TO SONORA, OAKDALE, and YOSEMITE.**
3. Stay on 120 through Oakdale – 108 will join 120 – travel east toward Sonora.

**ONCE YOU ARE ON 108, continue toward Sonora on 108, [120 turns toward Yosemite].**

1. When you get to Sonora, stay on Highway 108 on the bypass, about 2 miles, when it ends requires turning to the **RIGHT**, and then a **LEFT TURN – THIS IS MARKED TO PINECREST.** All the time you will stay on 108!
2. Continue east, past Twain Harte [about 11 miles]. Continue past the 2 turn offs, staying on Highway 108.
3. Continue on Highway 108 about 2 miles past the 2<sup>nd</sup> Twain Harte exit. Watch for a large green highway sign marked “Sugar Pine” - you’re almost there!
4. About a ¼ mile past the “Sugar Pine” sign, the first road on the **RIGHT**, angles off slightly to the right. Take this road it is marked ‘**Sugar Pine Road**’
5. Make the very first **RIGHT** turn on to “**Wild Cat Drive**”
6. Turn right at the first gravel road on to “**Crossley Way**” – this is our driveway!  
Stay on the gravel road past a house on the left, until you can turn **LEFT**, -- Go **STRAIGHT** to the end, past some old railroad signals. You have found us!

***All turns from 108 will be marked with yellow flagging.***
