LIMITED ENTRY: This Draft Test is open to **ALL Breeds** and has a limited entry totaling 24 entrants each day. Novice Draft, Open Draft, Novice Brace Draft and Open Brace Draft are offered. In the event that the Test fills, a drawing will be held as per the Draft Test Regulations. The drawing will be held within 48 hours of close of entries, and Alternates will be notified by phone.

Remember: please bring chairs, x-pens, and any other equipment you might need.

DIRECTIONS TO FORT MASON GREAT MEADOW:

FROM the SOUTH BAY via HWY. 280:

Take HWY. 280 NORTH to San Francisco. Follow signs to GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE (via 19th Avenue and Park Presidio). After passing through the Park Presidio Tunnel, take the DOWNTOWN/MARINA exit. Merge LEFT and follow the signs to MARINA BLVD. (Follow directions from Marin County at Marina Blvd. to Site, below.).

FROM MARIN COUNTY:

Take HWY. 101 SOUTH to San Francisco across the Golden Gate Bridge. After the toll plaza, merge to the left and follow the signs to MARINA BLVD. Stay on Marina Blvd. and turn LEFT at the BUCHANAN STREET signal into the FORT MASON PAVILION ENTRANCE (Safeway will be directly ahead to your right). There is open parking with time restrictions immediately upon entering, or you may proceed to the right where there is an entrance to a paid parking lot. Weekday rates are \$7 and weekends are \$8. (Follow Site Directions below.)

FROM the BAY BRIDGE or HWY. 101 N in the SOUTH BAY:

Follow signs to the US-101 N / MISSION ST exit toward VAN NESS AVE / G G BRIDGE. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto MISSION ST / US-101 N. Continue to follow US-101 N for approximately 2.1 miles. Be in the right lane to continue past LOMBARD ST / US-101. In 3 blocks, turn LEFT onto BAY STREET. After 4 blocks the right two lanes will turn RIGHT onto LAGUNA, which will go one block then turn left and become MARINA BLVD. Go one block and turn RIGHT at the BUCHANAN STREET signal into the FORT MASON PAVILION ENTRANCE (Safeway will be on your left).

SITE DIRECTIONS:

From the parking areas walk into Fort Mason at the signal where LAGUNA turns into MARINA BLVD. - there is a pedestrian entrance that will lead you directly to the test site, approximately 800 feet away. Please see the attached Fort Mason Center Map for additional information and an alternate drop-off location.
