ADDITIONAL SPECIALTY / OBEDIENCE / RALLY REGULATIONS

MOVE UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED—written move-up application must be submitted to the On-site Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial, not 30 minutes prior to the start of the class.

Regular Classes Each Day: Novice A, Novice B, Open A, Open B, Utility A, Utility B, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility. Refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations for a complete definition of each regular obedience class. No refund will be given for bitches that come into season after entries close.

- Telegraph, telephone, FAX and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies and conditions to its acceptance. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after entries have closed. RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- Trial site available from 7 am to one hour after conclusion of events.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- No refund for Bitches in season.
- American Kennel Club Rules regarding Conduct will be strictly enforced.
- Please fill out entry form legibly and completely. There will be no refunds for duplicate entries or errors on entry forms.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. No conditional or phone entries will be accepted. Entry forms will not be accepted without fees or signature. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to closing of entries.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- There will be no refund, after closing date, of any dog accepted in the trial if no alternate is available. Refunds will be given to alternates unable to run.
- Dogs MUST be on leash at all times, except when competing
- Dogs must be ready for their classes.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors, alone, are responsible for the behavior of their dogs/children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund on any fees paid will be made.

Take 37 East to 80 East. Exit Suisun Valley Road / Pittman Rd. Turn right onto Pittman Rd. Turn left onto Central Place. Approximately 9 1/4 miles. Travel time 10 minutes.
